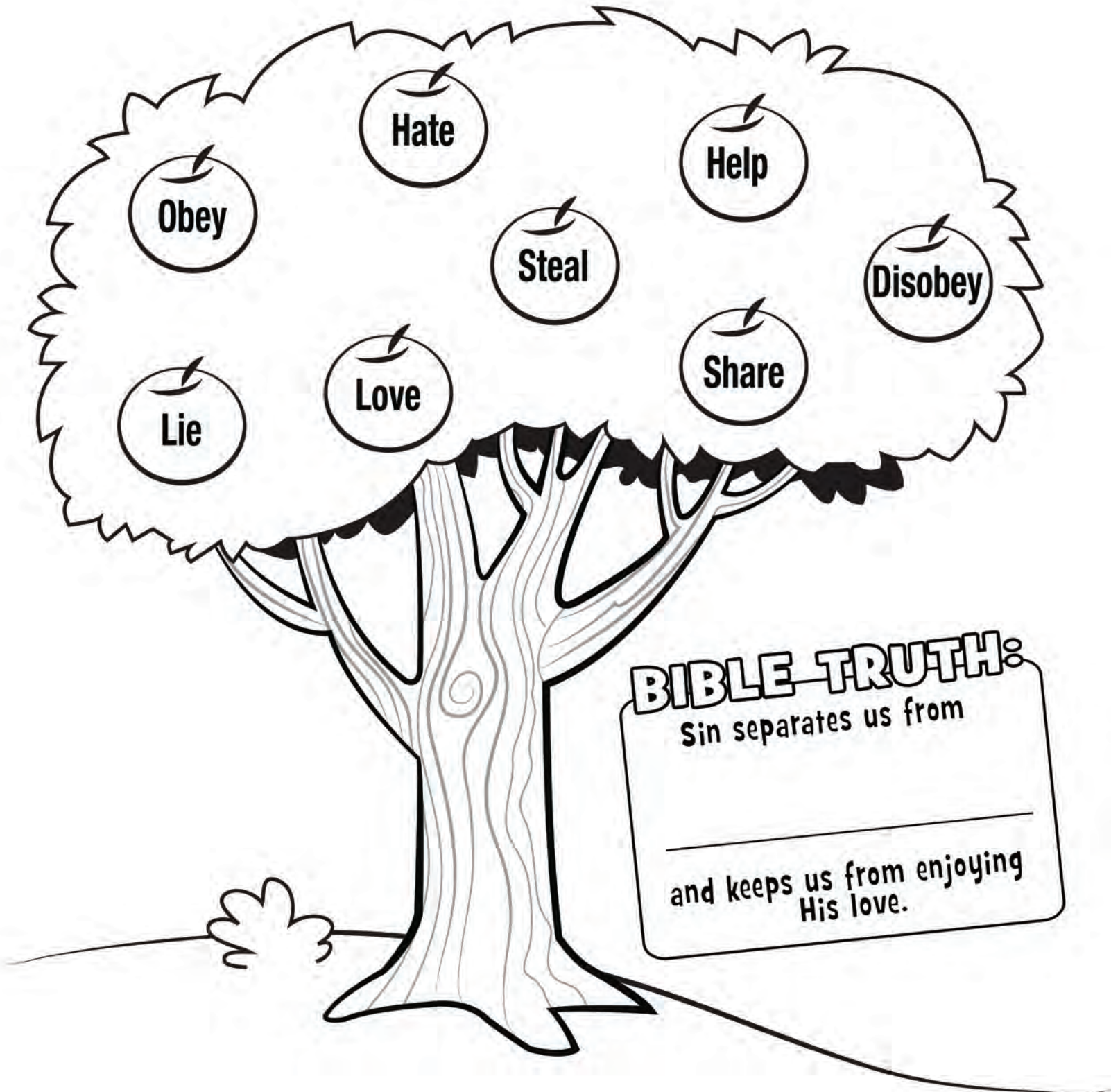



TO OBEY OR SIN?
